### **“OUR PARISH FUTURE – THE NEXT 50 YEARS”**

Just over 46 years ago, Bishop George L. Leech announced the establishment of our Parish. Due to the great faith and dedication of so many, including some who are still with us and many of our loved ones who have been called home to God, and guided by our former Pastors, Father Edward Deller and Father William Sullivan, our Parish has flourished into the vibrant faith community it is today.

Now, we are undertaking a Parish Feasibility Study as we look to the future. Over the past eight months, our Feasibility Study Committee has met and prayerfully discussed our hopes for the future, overseen Focus Sessions conducted with many groups within our Parish, and last month, we conducted our Parish wide survey. The summary of that Survey can be found on our Website and I wanted to share with you some of the highlights gleaned from it.

We received 684 responses, which is an outstanding level of interest, representing about 60% of our adult Sunday Mass attendees. Those who responded represented a fair cross section of our Parish and included about one-half of our School families and one-third of our PSR families.

1. 84.2 % (583) agreed that their “overall experience at St. Leo’s has been a positive one.” (# 5)  
This is a testimony to the wonderful life of faith lived by so many in our Parish. We thank God and hope to continue to share His love with so many in our Parish Family.
2. Only 9.8% (66) felt that they did not have a sense of “belonging at this Church”. (#6)
3. With regard to possible construction and/or expansion of a Parish Center/School, there, again seemed to be clear consensus:
  - a. 76.9 % (499) agreed or were open to “construction of a Parish Center with sufficient multi-purpose space and a large kitchen to accommodate Parish-wide events”. (#7)
  - b. 83.1 % (537) would support or were open to efforts “to enlarge our Parish School facilities.” (#12); while 92.7 % (607) would support or were open to “modernizing” our School facilities. (#13)
4. With regard to possible “reconstruction” to our existing Sanctuary in the Church, the largest number of Respondents favored some renovations to our brick steps for safety (259) and placing our Tabernacle in the center of our Sanctuary (251), although a slightly less number disagreed with some reconstruction (236) (#16; #17)
5. 84.7 % (552) were in favor of or open to the changing of the Sunday Anticipated Mass (Saturday evening) to either 4:00 p.m. or 4:30 p.m.






